The artworks included signed tour artwork from Coldplay, which went for £1,260, and Elaine Paige, whose 'Cats' themed butterfly sold for £770.

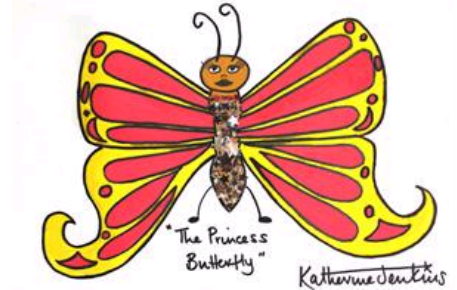
