

# **Bereavement Support**



# Keech Hospice Care offers a range of bereavement services to the family and friends of our patients.

### **Support for adults**

The monthly support groups give members an opportunity to share their feelings with others who have had a similar experience. This is done in a safe and confidential environment. Many people find comfort and understanding at these meetings.

## **Silver Lining support group**

Everyone who comes to Silver Lining has experienced the death of an adult. Meetings are held at the adult hospice between 7:30pm and 9:30pm once a month on a Thursday.

#### **Shoulders of Support (SOS) support group**

Everyone who comes to Shoulders of Support has experienced the death of a child. The aim of the group is to provide an opportunity for anyone affected by the death to get together on a regular basis to meet with others who have had a similar experience. Meetings are held at the adult hospice between 7:30pm and 9:30pm once a month on a Tuesday.

# **Talking Elephants support group**

Talking Elephants is a gathering of people who have been bereaved. The group meets for coffee and conversation on the first Wednesday of each month between 11:30am and 1:30pm, in the local community.

# Support for children (aged 5-18)

Children can experience the pain of loss as intensely as adults and they may find it difficult to talk to those close to them. Children benefit greatly from an opportunity to explore their feelings about death and may gain from meeting others who have had similar experiences.

# **Sparklers support group**

Sparklers is a support group which takes place on the third Saturday of every month (except in August) between 10:00am and 1:00pm. The children and young adults who come to Sparklers are experiencing, or have experienced, the death of an adult or child.

#### **One-to-one support**

We realise it can be daunting to share your feelings in a group. Some people prefer to talk to just one person. A family support worker or bereavement volunteer will see you at the hospice to give you an opportunity to share your feelings and talk about your loss. In some cases this support can be given at home or at school. One-to-one support is offered to both adults and children.

#### **Family Thanksgiving and Remembrance Services**

We hold separate adult and children's services throughout the year, which you will be invited to. However, the Light up a Life service invites everyone to dedicate a light on our Christmas tree in memory of their loved one. Services are held in early December when the tree is lit and it remains lit until the Twelfth Night.
